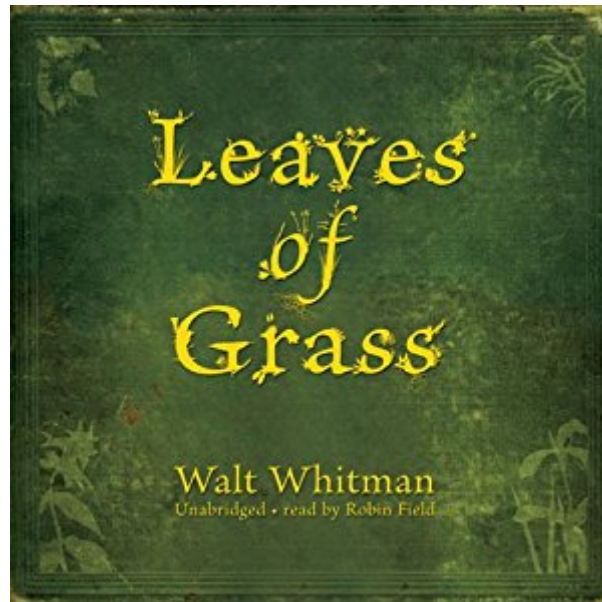

Leaves of Grass is a poetry collection by the American poet Walt Whitman. Leaves of Grass was highly controversial during its time for its explicit sexual imagery.
