

The commentary gives very scholarly information about the particular lectionary scriptures. It's interesting to see different perspectives on particular passages. Sometimes it gives me angles to pursue that I hadn't considered in thinking about the truth that the Bible is bringing about. Of course, I don't always agree with the commentator, but it gives me a way of addressing what I truly believe and digging deeper to find greater applications and truth in familiar and unfamiliar texts. I recommend it highly.
