

Otherwise I enjoyed the storyline, but thought some of the interesting characters could have been developed a little more.

Before you write another book, please learn how to spell. A VICIOUS dog is not a "viscous" dog. A scheme is a RUSE, not a "rouse!" It's a decent plot but the misuse of words and misspelling is distracting.
