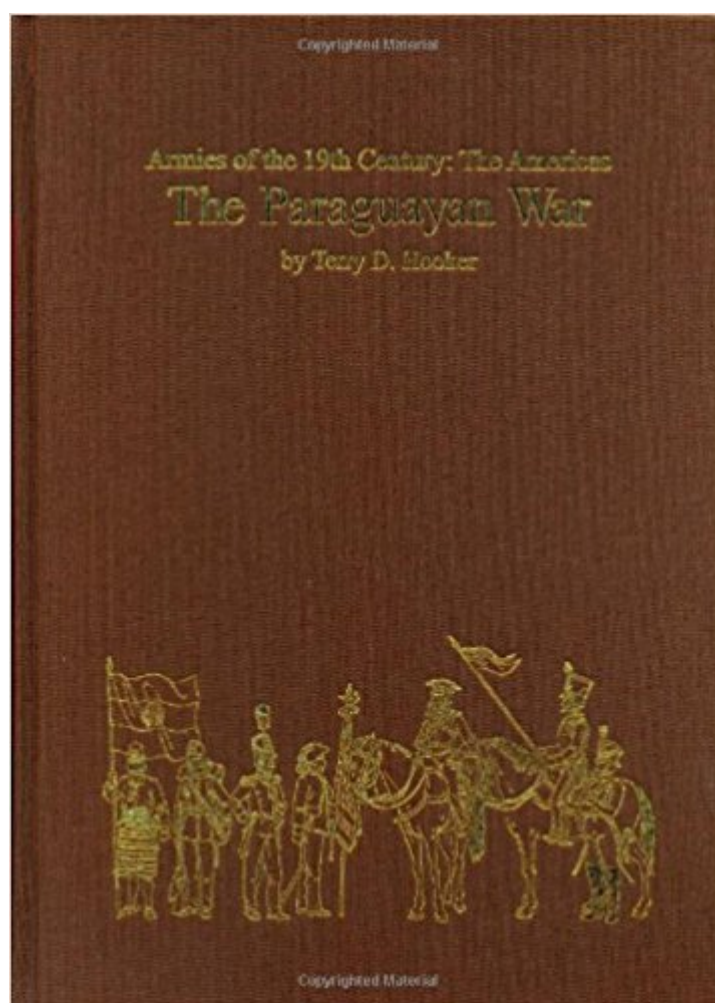

First what it is not: this is not a comprehensive history of the war and the participants. Hooker states at the beginning that he is writing a purely military book. In that he succeeds brilliantly. There are decent maps, numerous orders of battle, very useful battle

descriptions, descriptions of arms, equipment and organization and several hundred line drawings and uniform descriptions.
