

This book was a great disappointment. I thought it would include some wonderful Sizzix projects, but the projects are all so simplistic and "egg carton crafty" that I would not consider wasting my time on them. Some beautiful greeting cards or invitations with Sizzix dies would have been lovely. These projects are just dust collectors made by school children in craft class. I wish I had my money back. I'll use it as a re-gifter next Christmas for someone I don't like.

Was expecting more detailed how-to project directions. The ideas are original and well-crafted but for a novice crafter new to Sizzix, replicating is going to be challenging.

I expected more since there are so few books out there featuring Sizzix. The projects aren't ones that I would be particularly interested in. I should have paid more attention to the title. I don't regret buying it; just wanted more.

I felt for the cost of the product more content should have been included. A good opportunity to include recycle ideas from others was missed.
