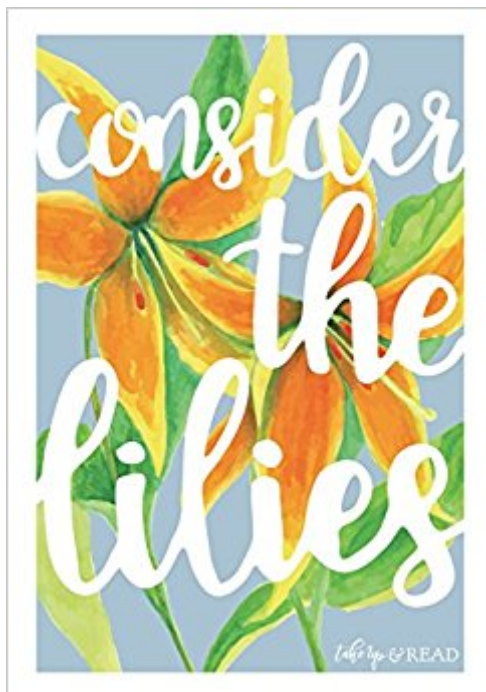

Step by step, day by day, these words console and bring clarity to the hard days. Maybe this is a difficult season in your lifeâ™re overwhelmed by the burdens weighing you down, the crosses the Heâ™s asked you to carry. You look heavenward and all you feel isâ | abandoned. This study is for you. It is full of the consolations of the Holy Spirit. Here, you will find a guidebook to what God is saying, how He is encouraging you to lament, to pour out your grief and your fears and your anger. This journal acknowledges that in this broken, fallen world we do suffer. Or maybe youâ™re in a sweet spot. Life is really rather good right now. Youâ™re not feeling any particular strain. If there is someone in your life who feels like they are drowning and need a lifeline (you do), this is for you. If you just want a deeper relationship with Jesus, this is for you.
