

Stelljes has it going on. Great plots with plenty of twists, plenty of action, and very well developed, believable characters. His whole series is absolutely worth your money, so Roger? Please write more!I'm giving four stars because, As a retired cop, the malaprop language regarding firearms drives me nuts. I can tell Stelljes has had good advice in writing these, so why doesn't somebody tell him that almost no modern firearms, and certainly not anything made by Sig Sauer or Glock, uses a clip - Its a bloody magazine, and not calling that screams that the author doesn't know what

they're talking about. Same goes for "bullets" - a bullet is the projectile, it's part of a round, which includes brass, primer, and powder. You don't load bullets in a clip - See above...Finally, as a lifelong hockey player and blue collar guy from a small town up north, I wish he'd left the getting rich and jumping into the big time out of the series, but that's just me.

Excellent mystery novel that turned into a "can't put it down" book. I effortlessly read this on my iPhone and Viewsonic gTablet using Kindle software. Sometimes with a questionable element of luck McRyan predictably succeeds in early chapters of the book. However, the mystery remains and turns to a strong need to get to the next chapter to find out what happens. In hindsight the early successes are key to character development and moving the story to more important elements. Well written and free from error this book should not be considered a local novel. Instead Stelljes has used St. Paul as an excellent backdrop and refreshing change from the status quo of Chicago or New York. The Minnesota landscape provides a perfect setting between rural and metropolitan scenes and managing a timeline tied to the seasons. On your Kindle you can't go wrong. In print this is a great read and a book you would want to pass to a friend when done.

I initially bought "Fatally Bound", and then when I learned that it was the fifth instalment in the series, I put it down and went back to the chronological beginning, which brought me to "The St. Paul Conspiracy." I must say (and I know many thriller readers will know what I mean) that it is difficult to imagine a major crime problem in the Twin Cities that does not get solved by Lucas Davenport. The introduction of this new hero in that region is going to be fun. The story told in this novel moved quickly, and the writing was great in that you could feel the frustration in the cops' minds before they got their big break. I will read the others in the series in quick succession, I enjoyed it so much.

This is Roger Stelljes second book I believe, (at least with the main character Mac McRyan in it,) and I'm thrilled to say that I feel as if I have discovered a new author to follow. I really like his style of writing, it seems to me that his main character Mac is almost almost a little (noir-ish? if you get my gist.)
