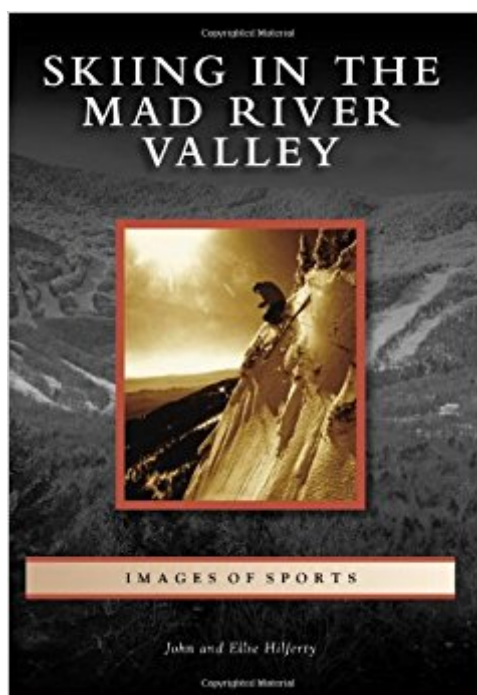

John and Ellie Hilferty fell in love with the Mad River Valley more than 25 years ago. In 2005, they authored The Mad River Valley for Arcadia Publishing's Images of America series.

Nice book but lots of typos, a few editors notes left in, and the picture quality was surprisingly, and exceptionally, poor for a book dependent on so many images. Certainly not what I'd expect from a \$28 book. If you're expecting something on the level of quality of John Christie's, "The Story of Sugarloaf" (like I was) you'll be very disappointed. Another well produced example is David Irons, "Sunday River: Honoring the Past, Embracing the Future". If you're looking for something that discussed backcountry ski options I'd recommend Lost Ski Areas of Southern Vermont or Best

Backcountry Skiing in the Northeast: 50 Classic Ski Tours In New England And New York - both must have's for any New England skier, regardless if you explore off the lift-served goods.-m
