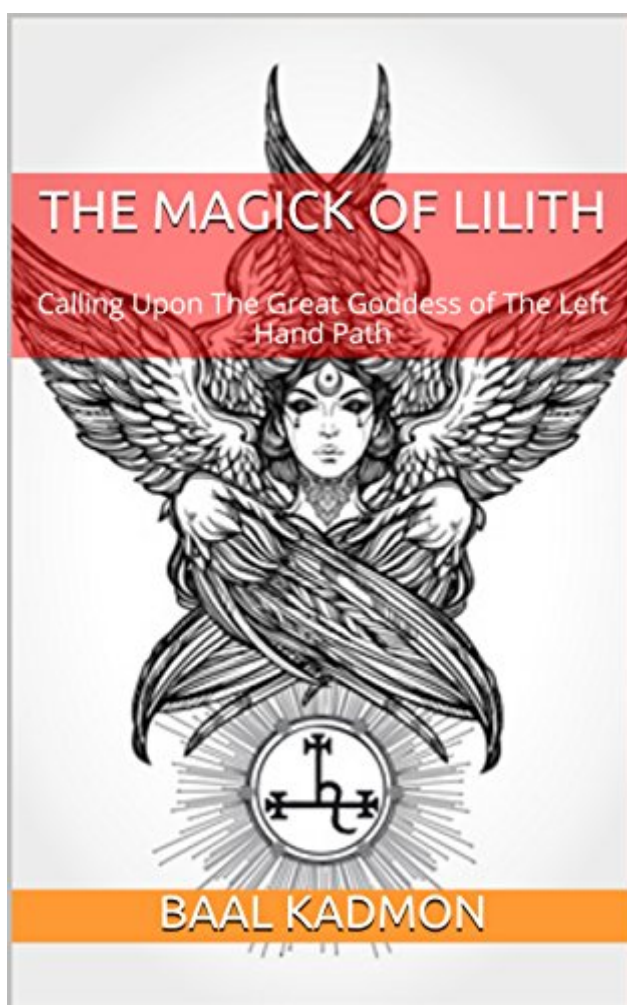

For an intro book, I found this to be quite helpful. Further more, I liked the opening prayer. Eloquent, and simple.

I love the book. I did a ritual and I have to say that Her energy was nothing like I expected. I was prepared to be scared a little from the tone of the book, but She didn't show any of that to me. I didn't believe the common mythologies surrounding her persona and I wanted to feel Her energies for myself. She was motherly, loving, sweet, and gentle... I also felt a "tough love" aspect in there. This was the first summoning of any God/dess energy where I had vivid and strange dreams leading up to the summoning. I actually dreamed I was an infant being suckled by the Goddess the night previous to summoning Lilith. It was very strange and primal.

I did like the book. Why only 3 Stars? I have an affinity with Lilith, had for a while, but I don't agree that she is limited for Pagans of the Left Hand Path. When Lilith appeared to me the first time, I was doing Inanna's Ritual Path to the Underworld. The first 2 times I found her sister Ereshkigal as expected. I stayed 2 days/nights, which were fraught with nightmares and feelings of depression during those 2 days. I had my husband watch over me and to pull me out in case I started behaving strangely. Each time, after I came back up, I had learned the lesson I needed to learn. Then one year during a Black Moon month (for those not familiar a Blue Moon means a month has 2 full moons, A Black Moon is a month with 2 Dark Moons. For some reason, I don't know why, I told my husband that I needed to go down to the Underworld on a Dark Moon and would stay until the next Dark Moon of the month. The descent was the same as the other times, but to my shock and surprise I did not meet Ereshkigal, in her place was Lilith, beautiful strong and dangerous. Don't know why but I did not feel fear, it was a feeling of awe. I can still picture smile in her beautiful face. Lilith wrapped me in her arms and I felt a part of her spirit entering me. A connection, that back then, I would not have expected. For the time I spiritually stayed in the Underworld with Lilith, I felt serene,

came and protected. Nothing that usually would stress me out affected me. As it happened we had booked a camping spot during the day of the full moon that month. It was fall, the campground near the ocean, almost empty and we stayed far away from anybody else. The only concern my husband had was that it was so windy he couldn't keep the fire going. I started a "Drawing down the Moon Ritual and as soon as the Circle was closed, the wind inside the Circle stopped. My husband, who is more or less open-minded atheistic often participates in Nature Rituals with me, as he doesn't like me out by myself in the dark. He has seen things before that have amazed him, but the wind going from almost stormy to completely calm amazed him. After our Ritual, we made an offer to Mother Earth and I carefully opened the circle. Boom! The wind came back with a vengeance. Towards the end of the month when my time in the Underworld would come to an end, I didn't want to leave. The moment I was thinking that, I felt Lilith's anger. Each night during that time, I went to sleep, felt wrapped in Lilith's arms and slept deeper and better than I had in a long time. I made my way up according to the Ritual and learned a lot. Long Story...To make a very long story short, Lilith has been with me and my Rituals went from good to almost on steroids. Although I do not identify as Wiccan and have always been more drawn to the Dark Goddesses, until I felt what a real affinity with a Deity is, I had no idea what I was missing. I would never curse anybody or wish ill on another person, never mind how much I dislike them. In that regard, I found the book misleading. While she is, in my opinion one of the most ancient and Dark Deities, she is also full of love and light. Lilith, as I experience my Goddess daily, is strong, wild and demanding, but to me even more so, protective and loving. I worked Rituals for about a year, just with Lilith and aside from my initial training in England, there was no time in my life I learned more. I was then ready to dedicate myself completely to her. I could feel her love and acceptance, and also her dominant and demanding side. Lilith put a stone in my path, that I wear together with my wedding band. She is my Mother, my Goddess, my Queen and taught me much. I love her deeply and just like with my wonderful husband, I would give my life for her. In one aspect I agree with Baal, she is not an easy Deity to work with, but would never tolerate me doing or wishing harm. And she makes it well known, if I'm not in accord with her Spirit. Lilith is not a Goddess you can approach with fear. If you just feel an ounce of apprehension, she is NOT the Goddess for you. But describing her as a Goddess limited for the left hand path is not only disrespecting all of her aspects, it limits the power of this amazing Goddess. I am sure there are Pagans, who do not walk the Left Hand Path but could have wonderful experiences working with Lilith. And I also believe, if you are not meant to be with her, all the Rituals described in the book, will simply be ignored by her. You do NOT get power over Lilith. I also think a warning is necessary, should the Rituals work, you might have attracted another Dark

Deity, which might or might not work out for you and could even be dangerous.

Always had the need to know more about Lilit and thanks to Baal Kadmon made it happen. I loved every second of this book and I loved how she thought her self as an EQUAL to Adam. Loved it loved it. I would recommend this to anyone's who has an open mind in acceptance how things should be in this universe.

The book is an excellent manual of magick for working w lillith AND provides a fascinating summary of the primary sources for the history and traditions of lillith. This goddess seems to dance in and out of biblical-khabbalistic history-discussion and she is a powerful and a valuable ally for majick. This work discusses the limited references to lillith then presents the ground rules for working w a goddess who is powerful and a bit fearsome.(The author stresses that offerings are a source of protection so always have meat chicken or eggs on hand). The rituals themselves are simple to perform. The more challenging aspect is CONNECTING w this goddess and that can take time. The ritual items such as the candles incense and using the book obviously is simple enough. The statue of lillith is sold on and runs about \$50.00 but think of wasted dinners and drinks and buying shoes that never fit right. A good downloaded image of lillith could be used as well but the statue captures her power majesty and beauty. In fact the figure's wings extend from the statue in such a way they mesmerize you, and remind you of her magical flying powers. At the same time this is not a blessed mother statue and i find myself instinctively attracted to her yet at the same time cautious and feeling a healthy respect and wariness. The rituals themselves are well detailed, kadmon style majick rituals which emphasize substance versus pomp, and this no nonsense approach is refreshing and appealing. There are rituals for protection, courage and confidence, to acquire or grow ones magical powers, to wreak havoc on your enemies and even a sexually based ritual for sexual connection w lillith. The scholarship and variety of rituals (the rituals are designed to incorporate that which is known of this mysterious goddess) make this a "must have" book for those interested in magical workings involving deities and in the very powerful lillith-- who is shrouded in

mystery but very real indeed!
