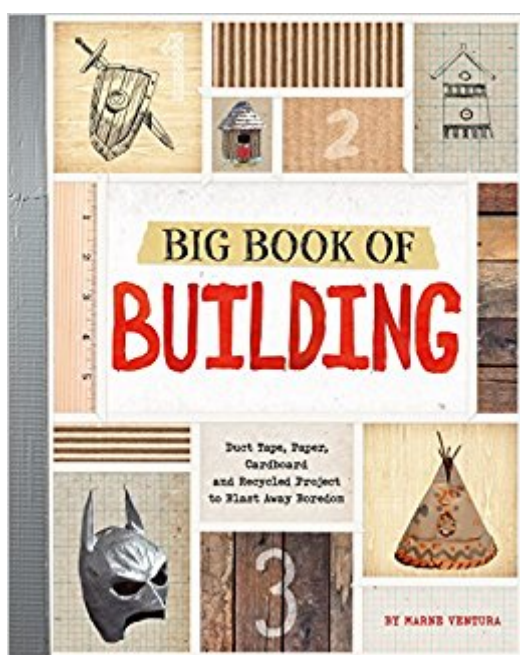

Some of the projects can be expensive -- requiring pizza boxes, pre-measured, dowels, and tubing, but others just require a few

extras, such as glue. Engage your kids in DIY: It fosters a lot of creativity. Own a box cutter for the cardboard stuff. The book lists in the front the few basic tools you will need. My favorite projects: the superhero mask and the hideaway book. There are many how-to-make-stuff books in the genre, but this is the most practical.

This book has a great variety of fun projects. Mostly using things we already have lying around the house.
